Wend through Cap aux Meules, the commercial heart of the isles then hike Parc des Buck or cycle the coast on trails that lead to soul-soothing views. Retreat to the forest on Havre Aubert Island; dig your toes in the sand at Dune-du-Nord beach, which was named one of Canada's top beaches; then find a bistro in Îles de Grande Entrée, designated as Quebec's Lobster Capital, for the best ruby reds in the world.

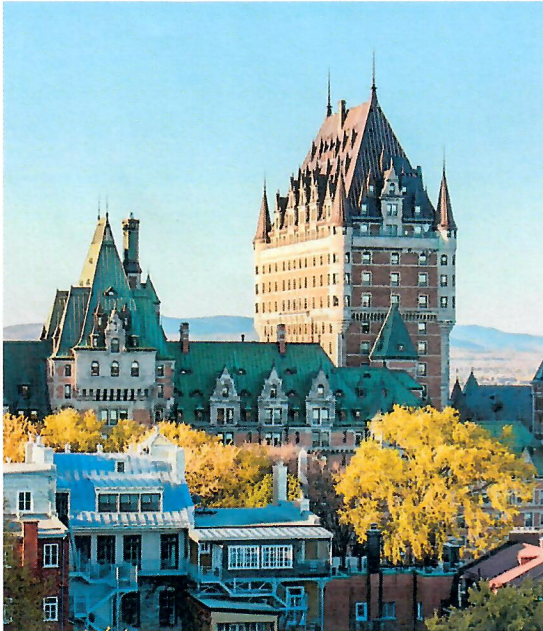

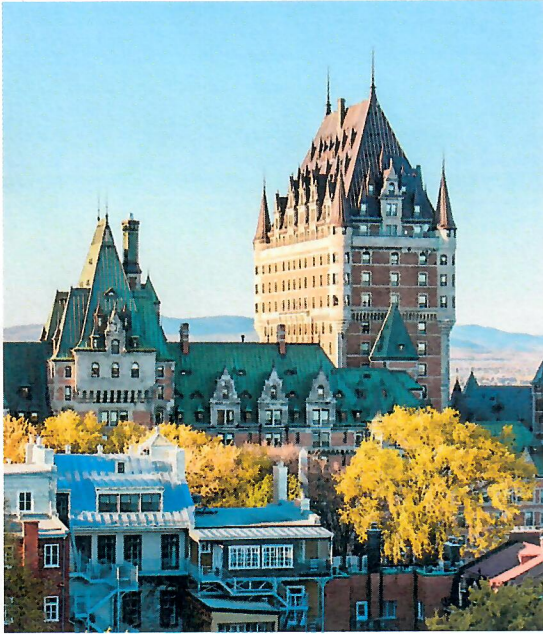
